## ***Consignment Highlights***

### ***RARE FISH***

The Ram is one of the most beautiful aquarium fishes. The wild Ram originates from the llanos of the Orinoco. The newest sport of this dwarf cichlid is blue all over the body. It is virtually impossible to illustrate this very special colour in a high resolution picture. Only reducing the resolution brings the effect to see the „Electric Blue“ coloration in a way as one sees the fish with bare eyes.

Dr. Axel Zarske found that the species imported for decades under the name *Boehlkea fredcochui* in truth represented a species of the genus *Knodus* so far unknown to science. The real *Boehlkea fredcochui* was now and then imported under the trade name *Boehlkea* sp. Sky Blue. So our good old aquarium fish is now named in honour of the aquarist Dieter Bork as *Knodus borki*.

## **Hyphessobrycon flammeus**

The Flame Tetra, Fire Tetra, or Von Rio Tetra is a well established aquarium guest. Its origin is the proximity of Rio de Janeiro in Eastern Brazil, where it occurs in coastal rivers. As swarm fishes they need the society of conspecifics. Since the optical impression of the observer depends on the swarm size, it makes little sense to pack small swarms of several similar looking species in the aquarium. Substantially more impressively a swarm of more than 30 animals of a species is to be held. Also the fish feel therein better, it obtains security and the colors begin to shine. With a length of 4cm the Von Rio Tetra is an

excellent candidate for large swarms, particularly since it has neither against the water condition nor against the food special requirements. Corys and small loricariids are suitable tankmates for the ground, hatchetfishes for the upper regions of the tank. (Photo F. Schäfer, Text K. Diehl)

### **Barbus denisonii**

This splendid fish is endemic (i.e. only there and nowhere else) found in several coastal rivers of South India. That is why only small quantities may be caught and exported as aquarium fish. You keep this fish best, which is used to flowing waters, in biggest tanks possible in a shoal. The feeding with frozen food and flakes is unproblematic. These animals are peacefully to other fish and also among each other. So far there are no news about a successful breeding. (Photo F. Schäfer, Text K. Diehl)

### **L114**

This fish is a member of the beautiful *Pseudacanthicus-leopardus* species group. The members of this species group can reach 25-30 cm total length, some sources give even 40 cm. They originate from the Rio Negro basin near Barcelos in Brazil. They are omnivorous, but prefer clearly meat. L114 almost refuses plant material, but they readily accept food tablets.

Breeding was successful in captivity already. They are cavebrooders with paternal eggcare. Breeding of

Pseudacanthicus is difficult due to the extreme aggressiveness of the adult fish. This makes it often impossible to keep pairs long enough together to enable breeding at all.
